

How to Knit



Start with cast-on stitches (see instructions of How to Cast On for help)



Insert right-hand needle into the front of your first stitch on your left-hand needle.



Hold the strand of yarn that is attached to your ball of wool in your right hand and bring to the back of your needles.



Wrap yarn anti-clockwise around the point of the right-hand needle.



Hold yarn with right-hand needle tightly as you slide the left needle along the right needle.




Pull the loop with the right-hand needle now over the top of the left-hand needle.



Slide the stitch off of the left-hand needle and you have knit your first stitch!



Repeat steps as before, keeping yarn in right hand held at the back of your work.



Continue knitting until you have completed the row, turn work and carry on.
