

# How to Sew Up



Thread wool needle through the corner stitch of your knitting.



Join this to the other corner of the piece of work you are sewing it to, with both right-sides facing you.



Insert the needle into the back of the first stitch behind the loop of the stitch in the row above.



Insert the needle into the back of the first stitch behind the loop of the stitch in the row above in the other piece.



This is how your work should look, tighten the thread holding the tail to ensure it doesn't pull out.



Continue ladder stitch into each row along your work (this is also known as mattress stitch).



This is how your work should look once you have completed sewing the seams together - nice and flat! Do not pull too tightly as it may wrinkle a little.



Sew along the reverse of your seam to stop it coming undone and cut your end. Sew in any unused ends.
